Most of the pieces for the show and sale were created specifically for the event and have never before been seen by the public. Pieces include various types of paintings, bronzes and sketches from 25 artists and can be purchased in person or online. Sale prices will range from \$1,000 to more than \$25,000 and will offer something for casual enthusiasts to avid collectors of rare and unique western art. Thirty-percent of each item sold in the "America's Horse in Art" show benefits the American Quarter Horse Foundation; the artist will receive the other 70 percent.
